- We treat each other with mutual respect in our words and actions.

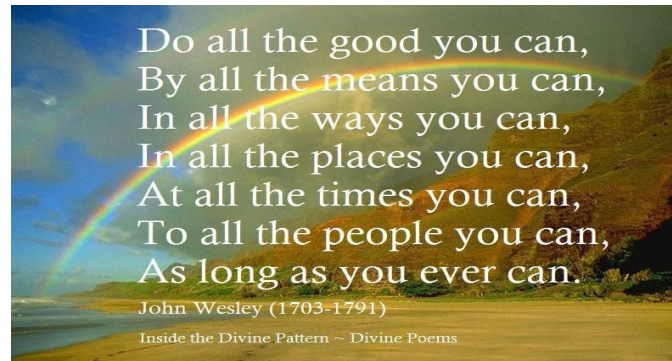
VALUED
